A. PURPOSE

This policy provides a framework to ensure that practices related to students meeting the requirements and criteria for continuing in their programs and graduation are applied consistently throughout the university.

B. SCOPE

This policy applies to all students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs at Alberta University of the Arts (AUArts).

C. POLICY STATEMENT

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Students at AUArts are required to maintain satisfactory academic performance to continue in their programs of study.
- 1.2 Students must complete required courses and meet specified conditions for graduation.

2. UNIVERSITY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 AUArts supports its students' academic performance. Academic standards, requirements, and criteria for continuing in and graduating from a program will be published and communicated to students in a clear and timely way.
- 2.2 AUArts will enact policies and procedures that support students' successful completion of programs while maintaining the institution's standards.

3. STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1 Students have a responsibility to be aware of their academic standing and other requirements and criteria for continuing in and completing their programs.
- 3.2 Students are responsible to take the required action if their ability to continue or successfully complete their programs is at risk.
