

EXCHANGE & STUDY ABROAD INCOMING STUDENT APPLICATION

Alberta University of the Arts, in conjunction with institutions from all over the world, participates in a unique international Exchange & Study Abroad Program that provides a cross-cultural experience while assisting students in attaining their educational goals.

The Exchange & Study Abroad Program provides the opportunity for students to attend Alberta University of the Arts (AUArts) during their third year of studies. Students remain registered with their home school and will pay all applicable tuition and fees to their home school as they would in any other year.

The program is designed to allow students to continue their academic progress and remain candidates for their degree at their home institution while attending Alberta University of the Arts. Students may apply to participate in the program for one or two semesters.

Participation in the program is based on meeting the University's academic eligibility criteria, available space, and the merit of the application and work submitted. Participation in the program is considered a privilege and at the sole discretion of AUArts.

Students with successful applications will be responsible for obtaining the necessary student visas and for all costs incurred while participating in the program including travel, accommodation and living costs.
