TOOLS

Standard Safety Glasses
 <u>OR</u>
 Safety glasses that fit over prescription glasses

Mandatory: Safety glasses: CSA (Canadian Standards Association) Eye Protection while in the studio. CSA Eye Protection must have a CSA, UL, SIE, etc. (national accredited testing organization) label or mark showing that it has passed testing and been approved. Prescription eyeglasses or sunglasses are not "impact resistant"; students who wear prescription glasses or sunglasses will also need to wear protective eyewear on top.

- Nitril gloves
- AUArts apron

Clothes you don't mind getting dirty

Scribe

Etching needle

- 1 piece of 12" x 17" (1.3 square feet) plexiglass
- 2ft x 3ft Tarletan
- At least 2 putty/palette knives
- Window/glass scrapper and blades
- Masking tape
- Pencils
- Sharpie/permanent marker
- White vinyl eraser
- Box of rags

OR

Rags from home (can be made from old clothing)

PAPER

- 18" x 24" Newsprint pad
- 1 piece of matboard (around 8.5" x 11")
- 2 sheets of 30" x 44" Stonehenge

4 sheets of 22" x 33" Maidstone

- OPTIONAL: Rice paper if you would like to experiment printing on another type of paper
- OPTIONAL: Sand paper for sanding the plexiglass
