#### **TOOLS**

Standard Safety Glasses
 <u>OR</u>
 Safety glasses that fit over prescription glasses

Mandatory: Safety glasses: CSA (Canadian Standards Association) Eye Protection while in the studio. CSA Eye Protection must have a CSA, UL, SIE, etc. (national accredited testing organization) label or mark showing that it has passed testing and been approved. Prescription eyeglasses or sunglasses are not "impact resistant"; students who wear prescription glasses or sunglasses will also need to wear protective eyewear on top.

- Nitril gloves
- AUArts apron

- Speedball Set of handle and 5 knives
- 6" x 6" Linoleum
- 6" x 12" Linoleum
- Speedball brayer/roller 6" wide
- Putty/palette knife
- Window/glass scrapper and blades
- Utility/x-acto knife
- Masking tape
- Pencils
- Sharpie/permanent markers
- White vinyl eraser
- Box of rags

Rags from home (can be made from old clothing)

#### **PAPER**

- 18" x 24" Newsprint pad
- Graphite transfer paper
- 4 sheets of 22" x 33" Maidstone
  OR

2 sheets of 30" x 44" Stonehenge

OPTIONAL: Rice paper if you would like to experiment printing on another type of paper
