Choosing Your First Year Courses

To help you get started in your first year course selection in the BFA Studio Art, we've prepared a quick guide to core courses that have been scheduled without conflicts. These are a great way to simplify the registration process – when using the registration system, you can enter the CRNs (course registration numbers) to get to the exact course section you need. If you're receiving transfer credit for any of the listed courses, you don't need to enrol in that course.

In the BFA, you can take up to five courses each term in your first year. You can take as few as three courses to be considered full-time – if you're planning on completing in four years, you'll want take the full five courses. There are ten courses required in the first year of the BFA Studio Art:
