Alberta University of the Arts (AUArts) is situated on the ancestral land of the Siksikaitsitapi – Blackfoot Confederacy which includes the Siksika, Kainai, Piikani Nations and the shared territories of the Tsuut'ina Nation as well as the Iyârhe Nakoda-Stoney which includes Bearspaw, Chiniki, Good Stoney Nations and also the home of the Métis Nation of District 5 and 6. The City of Calgary has long been called Moh'kins'tsis by the Siksikaitsitapi, Guts'ists'i by the Tsuut'ina, and Wichîspa by the Nakoda.

ABOUT THE ACADEMIC CALENDAR: FEES GUIDE

The Academic Calendar and the Academic Calendar: Fees Guide documents the cost of studies at AUArts for students in undergraduate, graduate, and bridging programs, as well as important guidelines for assessment and payment of fees. Tuition and fee rates in this guide are for the 2025-2026 Academic Year, as approved by the AUArts Board of Governors.

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FEE TYPE DETAILS

Students at AUArts are required to pay tuition, program fees, mandatory non-instructional fees, and third-party mandatory non-instructional fees for each term of their studies. The following is a guide to what is included in each fee type.

Tuition Fees are fees for instruction for courses that are part of an approved program of study. These fees are refundable up to the deadline to Add/Drop courses each term.

Program Fees are a subcategory of tuition fees for materials and services that facilitate instruction in courses that are part of an approved program of study. These resources are not directly related to the delivery of instruction in a course or program but are considered required elements of a course or program. These fees are refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed, the fees are non-refundable. The fee in this category is:

Supplementary Fees are program fees charged per studio course credit and subsidize resources that facilitate studio course instruction such as Educational Art Technician support, access to studio equipment and facilities, and other related services.

Mandatory Non-Instructional Fees are for specific goods or services that enhance the student experience and are required to complete an approved program of study and are not tuition fees or student organization membership fees. This includes fees for Network Access and Student Services. These fees are refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed, the fees are non-refundable. Fees in this category are:

Student Services Fee is a mandatory non-instructional fee which is assessed by term and provides access to student orientation, academic and financial advising, counselling and indigenous services, graduation application processing and convocation activities.

Network Access Fee is a mandatory non-instructional fee which subsidizes network access, Campus Wi-Fi, eduroam (world-wide roaming access service), AUArts email, general access computer labs and licensed software, Help Desk technical support, printing and copying machines, technical support in the IOLAB and Photo Print Lab for wide format printing machines, inkjet, vinyl cut and decal printing. A non-refundable print/copy credit of \$17.50 is applied to student ID Card account for each term the fee is assessed. Once the print/copy credit is spent, students may purchase more credits through the Help Desk. This fee is non-refundable after the Add/Drop deadline. These fees are refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed, the fees are non-refundable.

Third Party Mandatory Non-Instructional Fees are for access to specified services determined by a third party and all fee revenues flow through the institution to the third party. Includes fees for AUArts Student Association Membership, SAIT Wellness Centre, and Universal Transit Pass (UPASS).

Student Association Membership Fees are levied by the AUArts Students' Association on its members for the maintenance of the association. Student associations are granted authority to charge such fees through section 95(2)(e-f) of the Post-Secondary Learning Act. Membership fees are assessed for the fall, winter, and spring terms.

Student Association Health and Dental Benefits Plan is provided to students registered in the fall and winter terms. Students are automatically enrolled in the plan and are required to pay the associated fees.

SAIT Wellness Centre Fee provides access to the Wellness Centre, Aquatic Centre, general recreation programs and Intramural Sports Teams. This fee is refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed, the fees are non-refundable.

Universal Transit Pass (UPASS) Fee provides registered full-time students with unlimited access to Calgary Transit for Fall, Winter, and Spring terms.

In addition, students may be required to pay additional fees which are classified as Non-Regulated Fees.

Non-regulated Fees are for services that facilitate instruction where the material or equipment is retained or leased by the student, or for field trips. Unless otherwise indicated, these fees are non-refundable. Fees in this category are:

Confirmation Deposit is credited toward tuition fees if a new or returning student registers for the admitted term. Students who are approved to defer admission to another term retain their confirmation deposit. The confirmation deposit is a non-refundable fee.

Consumable Studio Share Fees are assessed to a student based on course registration. The fee subsidizes materials which are available to students working in a studio environment in Ceramics, Fibre, Glass, Media Arts and Print Media. The fee is also applied for a Ceramics field trip when the activity is scheduled biannually. These fees are refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed, the fees are non-refundable.

Equipment & Tools Fees are for specified kits, tools, equipment available to students based on their program and/or course registration. These fees are refundable up to the term Add/Drop deadline. After the Add/Drop deadline has passed the fees are non-refundable except for the refundable deposit portion which is credited at the end of the term if the loan agreement terms are completed satisfactorily.

User Fees are fees for goods, services, or activities that individuals may request on an as-needed basis. Students are not required to pay these fees in order to enroll in or complete their program of study.

ASSESSMENT AND PAYMENT OF FEES

Total student fees are a combination of tuition fees, mandatory non-instructional fees, user fees, non-regulated fees and AUArts' Students Association fees. Fees are assessed on the basis of course registration, status, term of study, service requests and membership as per the fee description. Tuition fees will cover a portion of expendable supplies necessary to support general studio operation and use. The balance may be charged to students as supplementary fees on a cost recovery basis.

All tuition fees, program fees (if applicable), mandatory fees, non-regulated fees, and third-party mandatory non-instructional fees, including Student Association fees, are due and payable by the payment deadline as published in the Academic Calendar. Where the deadline is a weekend day, the fees due date will be moved to the next business day.

Tuition Rates

AUArts maintains two tuition rates for all post-secondary students, domestic and international.

Students who fall into the following categories will be assessed tuition and fees at the domestic rate:

1. Canadian Citizens
2. Permanent Residents
3. Convention refugees or protected persons and their dependent children
4. Diplomats assigned to Canada and their dependent children

All other students (including non-Canadian citizens with valid study permits) will be assessed tuition and fees at the international rate.

Fee Payment Deadlines for the 2025 – 2026 Academic Year:

- Fall semester: September 16, 2025.
- Winter semester: January 16, 2026.
- Spring semester: May 7, 2026.
- Spring/Summer semester (Graduate Studies): May 7, 2026.

Students who have not paid all tuition and fees by the fee payment deadline may have their registration in the current term revoked and will not be eligible for refund of fees paid to date. Future term registration will be cancelled.

Students with unpaid balances on their accounts at AUArts will be subject to:

- Withholding of marks, transcripts and/or credentials;
- Withholding of privileges, including access to AUArts email, Mosaic, and other student systems, building access and other AUArts services;
- Ineligibility to register in subsequent academic terms or years;
- Any other collection efforts that are deemed appropriate by the University.

Methods of Payment

You can pay your undergraduate or graduate tuition and fees through webService, online banking, wire payments, mail, and Aeroplan Miles.

FEE REFUNDS

Course Changes - During Add/Drop Period

If a student drops/deregisters from a course in their schedule before the Add/Drop Period as defined in the Academic Schedule (Dates & Deadlines), tuition and any refundable fees will be reversed. If the course change results in a registration status change (i.e. from full-time to part-time), non-instructional fees will be reassessed accordingly.

Fee Payment Deadlines for the 2025 – 2026 Academic Year:

- Fall semester: September 16, 2025.
- Winter semester: January 16, 2026.
- Spring semester: May 7, 2026.
- Spring/Summer semester (Graduate Studies): May 7, 2026.

Withdrawal from Courses – After Add/ Drop Period

Students who withdraw (W) from courses, **after** the Add/ Drop Period up to the Withdraw deadline as defined in the Academic Schedule (Dates & Deadlines), will not receive any reduction in tuition and fees for the term.

Students who withdraw with cause (WC) from courses will not receive any reduction in tuition and fees for the term.

Students whose withdrawal is required (WR), as a consequence of the student conduct procedure, will not receive any reduction in tuition and fees for the term.

Withdraw Deadlines for the 2025-2026 Academic Year:

- Fall semester: December 2, 2025
- Winter semester: April 1, 2026.
- Spring semester: June 12, 2026.
- Spring/Summer semester (Graduate Studies): July 24, 2026.

Tuition and Fees

Alberta University of the Arts Board of Governors determines tuition and student fees based on Government requirements and/or allowances as set out in the Province of Alberta's Tuition and Fee Regulations, a component of the Post-secondary Learning Act. All fees are set in consultation with the Alberta University of the Arts Students' Association. The Board reserves the right to change fees and deposits when necessary and without notice.

Estimated Undergraduate Program Cost – First Year Studies

Charges for tuition and fees are based on course registrations and student status. The following is an estimate for the cost for registration in a year (two terms) of a full, ten course (30 credit) load in the 2025-2026 year:

Students who are applying for student loans, should enter the full amount of their computer and related costs although student loans may not cover the full cost of computer and related expenses.

Undergraduate Tuition per Credit

The following fees are charged to all undergraduate students and are refundable up to the deadline to Add/Drop courses each term.

Undergraduate courses at AUArts are typically 3.0 or 4.5 credits (4.5 hours | Studio) over one term. A full course load per year is 30 credits (15 per term in each of the Fall and Winter terms), although the minimum requirement for full-time student status is 9 credits per term.
